## Judge Gilbert A. Smith, Jr., Speaks at June General Membership Meeting



Judge Gilbert A. Smith Jr. was the guest speaker at the June Annual Membership Meeting of the MCBA. Donning a suit that an attorney practicing during the 1920s would wear, Judge Smith gave a very informative and entertaining presentation regarding MCBA history. Attendees were delighted to learn of our association's diverse and sometimes quite surprising heritage. Judge Smith discussed the association's beginnings, founders, early judges, noteworthy cases and scandals. Overheard was one attendee saying to another that some of the earlier MCBA members were "pretty tough" and similar to those found in an "old western" movie. Judge Smith also shared historical events, such as a murder case heard during the year 1885 regarding the infamous "Sarasota Assassins Society"; which was found in newspapers nationwide, such as the New York Times.

Judge Smith served as president of the Manatee County Bar Association from 2003 to 2004. He grew up in Bradenton and graduated from Manatee High School, Manatee Junior College, University of South Florida and University Of Pacific law school. He practiced law for 20 years before being elected as circuit judge of the 12th Judicial Circuit in 2008. Judge Smith believes that the Manatee County Bar Association has a rich history which needs to be preserved for future generations.

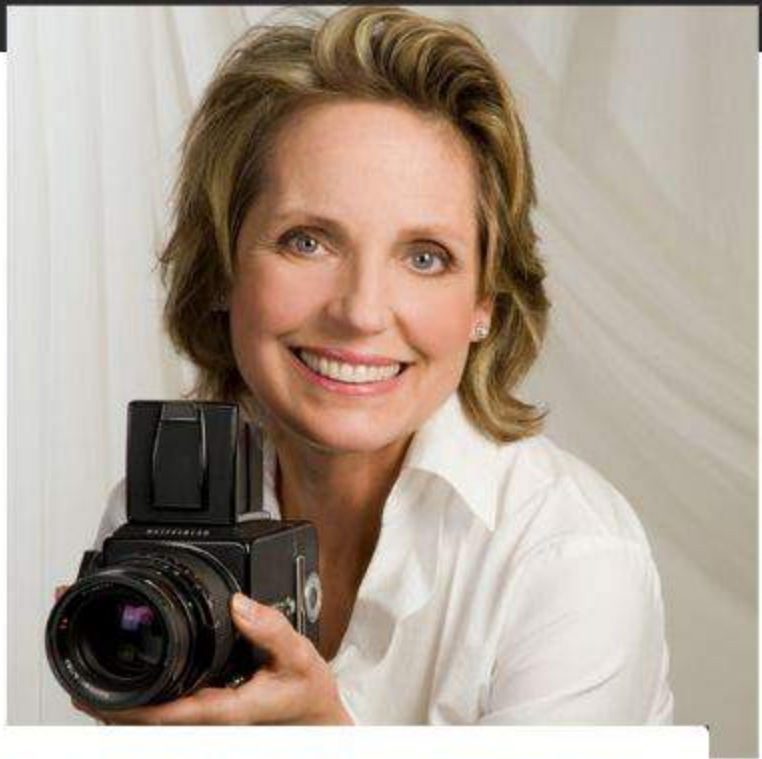
