## President's Message - Summer 2020

### Thoughts On A Lawyer's Role in a Free Society

e can all agree that the United States is extraordinarily heterogeneous. That diversity brings more conflict and less agreement regarding social customs and thus, more necessity for lawyers to help mediate across that diversity or, as Madison said, those factions.

Of late, it seems that we are, as a country, less tolerant of the views of others and insist that, as an officer used to say when I was in the military: "it's my way or the highway." While that may work well in the military, there is an insidious danger in that approach for a free society. To create a collective will, one must destroy all of those wills that run counter to your vision of the general will.

The most tragic impediment to open conversations about any issue that is considered contentious (and there are too many to list in this article) is fear. Fear that free speech will result in retribution limit the kinds of topics people can rationally discuss

and what type of conclusions are permissible. This bodes ill for the development of knowledge.

Stated another way, free speech is useful for developing and testing ideas in the search for truth. When only certain segments of society are comfortable sharing their opinions, we end up with a skewed outlook of the world. "He who knows only his own side of the case knows little of that." John Stuart Mill.

Further, free speech is a critical component of a democracy. Free speech is a human right and is critical for the individual. It is important that people can say what they feel, express ideas, question authority and not worry that they will be unjustly punished for it. Free speech is designed to protect speech that we may hate.

How do we play into this? We lead from the front. First and foremost, we must work to protect the rights of individuals to engage in free speech – yes, even the speech we hate. Second,

# News from the 12th Judicial Circuit: COURT UPDATES JACS

The Court has updated its JACS calendaring system (Judicial Automated Scheduling System) to schedule hearings. As of July 31, 2020, you will no longer be able to login directly and schedule in JACS with your Florida Bar Number. Attorneys who have scheduled in JACS in the past twelve months should have already received an email about this.

To access JACS you will need to do two things:

- Setup an account on our website [jud12.flcourts.org/ attorney]; and
- 2. Setup Attorney Access from this new account.

If you're on our court-appointed attorney list for FY 20/21, you've already done this! For those who haven't, once registered, you'll be able to use one login and password to access your subscriber features, the online court appointed attorney applications and schedule hearings on JACS. As an added benefit, if you forget your password, you'll be able to reset it immediately from the login page, eliminating the need to contact the court's Help Desk to change your password.

To ease the transition, we ask that you please begin the process as soon as possible. For instructions to get registered, please go to <u>jud12.flcourts.org/attorney</u>. The website also has two short videos to assist with this process.
